Congratulations on your assignment to the NCAA Championship tournament, April 4-6, 2000 at the Ohio State University in Columbus. The NCAA tournament is the most prestigious and historic gymnastic event in our country. The athletes will prepare all year for these meets, and they expect the officials will be equally prepared. In this first year of new code it is particularly important to prepare thoroughly and be up to date on all recent rules updates.

You were selected to judge NCAAs because your name was submitted among a list of very qualified, competent and experienced judges. As always, a judge's performance is held to a very high standard and mistakes are not tolerated. Your successful preparation and performance at NCAAs will enhance your personal reputation as a good judge. It will also enhance the reputation of the NGJA as an organization that can provide well trained officials for college competitions.

Please take the time this year to become an expert on the events that you are assigned to. Coaches and gymnasts are adapting their routines according to the latest interpretations to maximize their possible score. You MUST be ready for anything and everything to award the score that the gymnast deserves. You must be familiar with the Code of Points, the FIG interpretations, the NCAA rules, and the NGJA Interpretations for the events you will be judging. Ensure that you closely review the NCAA pre-competition forms prior to the competition.

You should have been contacted by the NCAA to make your travel and hotel arrangements. Make sure that you are on time for all flights and scheduled meetings.







The top 12 nationally ranked teams will compete in two NCAA Team preliminary sessions on Thursday; six teams in each session. The top 3 teams from each of the two preliminary sessions qualify into the team finals on Friday. Please notice that there will be 24 judges for the NCAA Team Preliminaries and Team Finals on Thursday and Friday. However, there will only be 12 judges used at the Individual Finals on Saturday.

The 12 judges who are NOT judging the Individual Finals on Saturday are welcome to stay at the championships through Sunday. The NCAA will provide you hotel, but will not pay per diem nor honorarium for the extra day.




