Step 1: RTD Nominations:

RTDs should compile a list of qualified and available candidates that meet the criteria below by a due date set by the NGJA National Technical Vice President.

- Nominations should be a mixture of new and experienced judges
- Judges availability should be confirmed by RTDs for BOTH the NCAA and Conference Championships
- Judge nomination criteria are:
 - Participated in that season's NCAA Judges Challenge
 - Judged at least two collegiate meets for each of the previous three seasons
 - Judged at least one Conference Championship meet in the past three years
 - Be a National Cardholder and a member in good-standing of the NGJA
 - Have NOT officiated the two most recent NCAA Championships
- RTDs will allow each Judge in their region to be nominated (if the Judge so chooses) if the Judge meets the above nomination criteria
- RTDs will nominate candidates in relation to their Conference using the following:
 - RTD East Region nominates 7 names for ECAC and 3 names for Big Ten
 - RTD Mid-East Region nominates 8 names for Big Ten and 2 names for ECAC
 - RTD Mid-West Region nominates 6 names for MPSF and 4 names for Big Ten
 - RTD West Region nominates 10 names for MPSF
 - RTD's will ensure a minimum of one judge is nominated that is local to each college team.

Step 2: NGJA Nominations

- Each Conference will have 10 judges nominated
- Each Conference will have two (2) Head Judges
- The NGJA (National Technical Vice President and NGJA President) will create balance on each panel from the three conferences: ECAC; Big 10; and MPSF
- The NGJA will create balance between new & experienced judges, but will try to have at least at least six (6) judges who have experience judging large competitions, such as USA Championships.










Select D1s: No conference can have more than 2 D1s.

Select D2s: No conference can have more than 2 D2s and each conference must have 4 total D1s and D2s. No conference can have a D1 & D2 on the same event.





Select E3s: No conference can have more than 3 E3s and each conference must have 10 judges total. No conference can have more than 3 judges on one event.




