

Mark Cuyjet passed away early on October 23, 2020, at the age of 66, as a result of a congenital nerve disease that had taken his father around the same age. He was an active judge for many years until he could no longer write fast enough to record what he saw. Mark got his start in the Philadelphia Public League. After that, he was an all-around gymnast at Temple U from 1972-76 and had an excellent career. He was assistant coach for the Owls twice and began his judging career shortly after graduating. He judged extensively in both the US Jr Olympic and the NCAA programs and has been inducted into the EGJA Hall of Fame. Mark will certainly be missed by all in Region 7.
