I thought I would drop you a note to further clarify our conversation in Philadelphia this past weekend. I believe the points we covered were as follows:

1. That the N.G.J.A. would send three judges to the N.A.A.U. Championships to be held in Miami, Florida.
2. That two of the judges would be out of the Mid-West and the third would be sent from California.
3. All three judges would be competent and nationally certified.
4. That the A.A.U. would make a partial monetary compensation, but the rest of the judges expenses would be assumed by our organization.
5. That you would present to the A.A.U. our wishes that they join our organization as an auxiliary member (Fee \$100)

Could you please find out the procedure we must follow as annational organization in obtaining membership and a vote in the A.A.U.?
