Dear Bill,

Thank you for your letter of April 7th relative to our conversation in Philadelphia this past weekend. In regard to the two judges from the Mid-West and one from California, for the National AAU competition, the A.A.U. will be able to make a partial monetary compensation, but the major expenses would be assumed by your organization.
