BOARD MEETING

APRIL 6, 1973

EUGENE HOTEL, EUGENE, OREGON

The Board Meeting was called to order at 9:45 a.m. by President, Frank Cumiskey.

Roll call was taken by Secretary, Jerry Todd. Present were Frank Cumiskey, Ted Muzyczko, Robert Stout, Bob Fisher.

Jerry Todd passed out copies of the minutes that had been previously mailed. They were accepted as written.

ELECTIONS

Frank Cumiskey discussed the running of elections for regional directors. He felt that each area should submit nominations. After all nominations are in, a ballot be sent to each individual regional or national card holder of that region to vote for their regional director. Ted Muzyczko said that in the mid-east they have an election meeting. Other regions are too widespread for this.

RULES FOR ELECTING REGIONAL DIRECTORS

1. Each regional or national card holder has one vote;
2. The regional director is voted on first;
3. Each present regional-director is responsible for his official ballots;
4. After regional director for each area is selected, two at large directors shall be elected by sending a nominating ballot to each regional and national card holder in the U.S.A. All nominations must be back by June 1st. Nominees then must be voted on by October 1st;
5. The use of a secret ballot is prescribed.

OFFICERS AND TECHNICAL CHAIRMEN

The Board of Directors elects its officers. Nominations for technical committee may come from anywhere and are voted on by each region with no one region having more than a one vote advantage over any other region.

NEW BUSINESS

Jerry Todd brought up the idea of weeding out the file of material being kept by the secretary. It was decided that any material over three years old could be discarded.

STUDENT GAMES

Three people: Fred Orlofsky, Bill Roetzheim (Mid-East), and Jerry Wright (West) were nominated to judge the Student Games.

The requirements were: F. I. G., card holder; full-time school employee; not had position previously.

The meeting was adjourned by President, Frank Cumiskey at 10:15 a.m.
