

NATIONAL GYMNASTIC JUDGES ASSOCIATION

Executive Committee Meeting

November 19, 1976 Fairmont Hotel, Dallas, Texas

The meeting was called to order by Ted Muzyczko at 7:45 PM.
Present were: Ted Muzyczko, Jon Culbertson, Bob Stout, Bob Fisher, Ken Allen, Jerry Todd, Jerry Wright, Les Sasvary.

Absent: Bill Roetzheim

The minutes of the last Executive Committee Meeting was accepted as read.

Ted Muzyczko spoke first on the following:

1. New evaluation form for National Certification Courses was designed. These new forms will help Technical Directors to evaluate course result in a matter of minutes.
2. Proposes the creation of In-Training category for judges.
MSP 8 - 0
3. The Constitutional Amendments were mailed out to the membership for voting.
4. As of January 1, 77 a new version of NGJA "Blue Book" will be available for distribution. Price: \$ 2.50 per book.
5. NGJA should look for some ideas to raise money. The sale of pins, patches, tapes, films were discussed.

Jerry Todd pointed out that the Regional Judge Award has no criteria. The Executive Committee appointed Jerry to set up criterias.

Les Sasvary reported on the following:

1. 1977 is election year
2. Reports on courses coming in regularly.
3. NGJA has 12 active associations at present. FIG cardholders: 26, National cardholders: 240, Regional cardholders: 99.
4. USGF council meeting.

Jerry Todd gave his financial report. NGJA presently has \$ 1433.35 in the bank. This will be considerably less after the USGF Congress.

New business:

Oklahoma Gymnastic Judges Association submitted constitution and a request for admission to NGJA.

Jon Culbertson made the motion that we admit Oklahoma to the NGJA as of November 19, 1976, second, Fisher. MSP 8 - 0

Montana Gymnastic Judges Association submitted constitution and a request for admission to NGJA.

Ken Allen made the motion that we admit Montana to NGJA, second Todd. MSP 8-0

The number of active organizations are now 14.

There was considerable discussion on the financial situation of NGJA. Air fare two times per year is becoming a tremendous burden for officers of NGJA.

Ken Allen made the motion that financial help be considered for officers of NGJA for travel. Second Todd.

Voting was 4 - 4 tie.

Jerry Todd requested that a round trip coach air-fare of 228.00 be paid to either Sasvary or Todd since they both belong to the Southern California Gymnastic Judges Association and both are officers of NGJA.

Jon Culbertson made a motion that the money requested be paid, second Allen. MSP 8 - 0

The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 PM.
